

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the Port Allegany School District does, from time to time, employ teachers, secretaries, instructional aides, cafeteria staff, and janitorial personnel. Persons interested in being considered on a full-time or substitute basis should make written application through the Superintendent's Office.

Current applications shall constitute the applicant pool from which qualified persons will be selected. Initial selections of persons to be hired shall be made by the appropriate principal or supervisor with the concurrence of the Superintendent and shall be forwarded to the Board of School Directors for ratification or approval.
