Who was your favorite teacher in high school? Why were they your favorite?

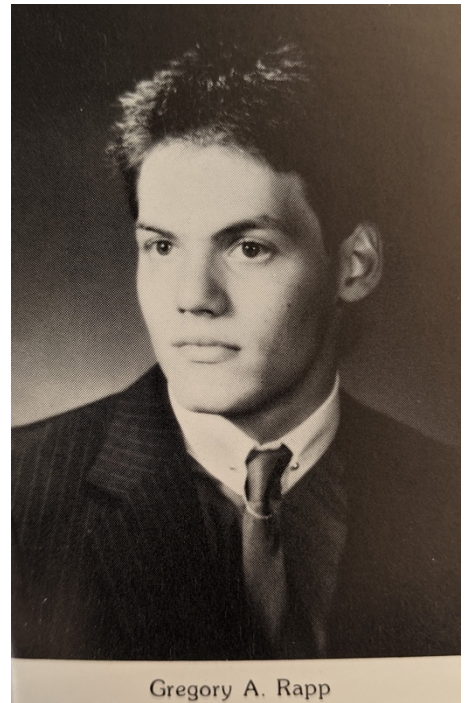
It is hard to choose just one, but Mrs. June Dunn.
